The warehouse boost of a 690,500-sf warehouse that will bring an additional 600 jobs to the area.

"Montgomery County's infrastructure assets, like the I-70/I-75 Interchange, allow Chewy and other companies to access customers in 60 percent of the U.S. and Canada within one day," said Montgomery County Commissioner Debbie Lieberman. "We believe the Dayton Region offers our companies faster speed to market, less risk and a lower cost of doing business."

The Dayton International Airport sits on more than 5,000 acres of land and utilizes about 2500 acres for the day to day operations of the Dayton International Airport (DAY). Over the past 4 years the City of Dayton, in partnership with Montgomery County, Downtown Dayton Coalition (DDC) and Jobs Ohio; have thought outside the box to find ways to develop the underutilized land.

"We are appreciative of Chewy selection to bring their business to the City of Dayton, recognizing there were a lot of options. The pledge to create new jobs will have a great impact on the City's ongoing development at the airport," said Dayton City Manager, Shelley Dickstein.
